Our primary purpose is to stay free from cocaine and all other mind-altering substances, and to help others achieve the same freedom.

We use the Twelves Steps of recovery because it has already been proven that the Twelve-Step recovery program works.

It is a custom in Cocaine Anonymous to read Chapter 5 *How it Works* from the big book of Alcoholics Anonymous on P. 58.

On Page 15 par 3 of "Twelve Steps and Twelve Traditions" it states, "A.A.'s Twelve Steps are a group of principles, spiritual in their nature, which, if practiced as a way of life, can expel the obsession to drink and enable the sufferer to be happily and usefully whole.
